Waikato gets its name from the Waikato River which runs through the district. Māori see the river as an ancestor and provider of life and nourishment. Waikato is also connected with the well known haka chanted by the All Blacks – 'Ka mate, ka mate' and also the home of the Kingitanga (the Māori King movement). This was formed in the 19th century to unite the Māori tribes. To learn more about the history of this area including the Waikato Land Wars and the Kingitanga movement visit Te Ara Wai journeys.
